Virginia Plan

Proposed by <u>EDMUND RANDOLPH</u> of VIRGINIA

Called for a <u>STRONG</u> national government with <u>3</u> branches

- LEGISLATIVE
- **▶** EXECUTIVE
- **▶** JUDICIAL

Consists of <u>2</u> houses: BOTH based on POPULATION

VS.

The Great Compromise

in the
LEGISLATIVE BRANCH
2 Houses

Upper House:

Senate

Each state has two Senators/votes regardless of its size

Lower House:

House of Representatives

Representation is based on population

New Jersey Plan

Proposed by
WILLIAM PATERSON
of NEW JERSEY

Called for a <u>STRONG</u> national government with 3 branches

- ▶ LEGISLATIVE-
- EXECUTIVE
- JUDICIAL

Consists of <u>1</u> house: based on EQUAL REPRESENTATION

Constitution Day!

SEPTEMBER 17, 1787

(<u>RHODE ISLAND</u> was the last state to sign)
