- 1. Bitter Cold
 - FROSTBITE
 - Froze to Death
- 2. Poor NUTRITION
 - Starvation / Malnutrition
 - Spoiled
 - "FIRECAKES"
- 3. Disease Outbreaks
 - LICE / TYPHUS
 - INFLUENZA / TYPHOID FEVER
 - <u>SMALLPOX</u>
 - Required inoculation:
 ALL NEW SOLDIERS RECEIVED
 A SMALL DOSE OF SMALLPOX
 TO HELP CONTROL THE
 EPIDEMIC
- 4. Poor Conditions
 - Shortages of adequate HOUSING & CLOTHING
 - Slept on cold, muddy floors, or on straw mattresses
 - <u>COLD</u> + <u>HUNGER</u> = <u>WEAKENED IMMUNE SYSTEM</u> = HIGH DEATH RATES
