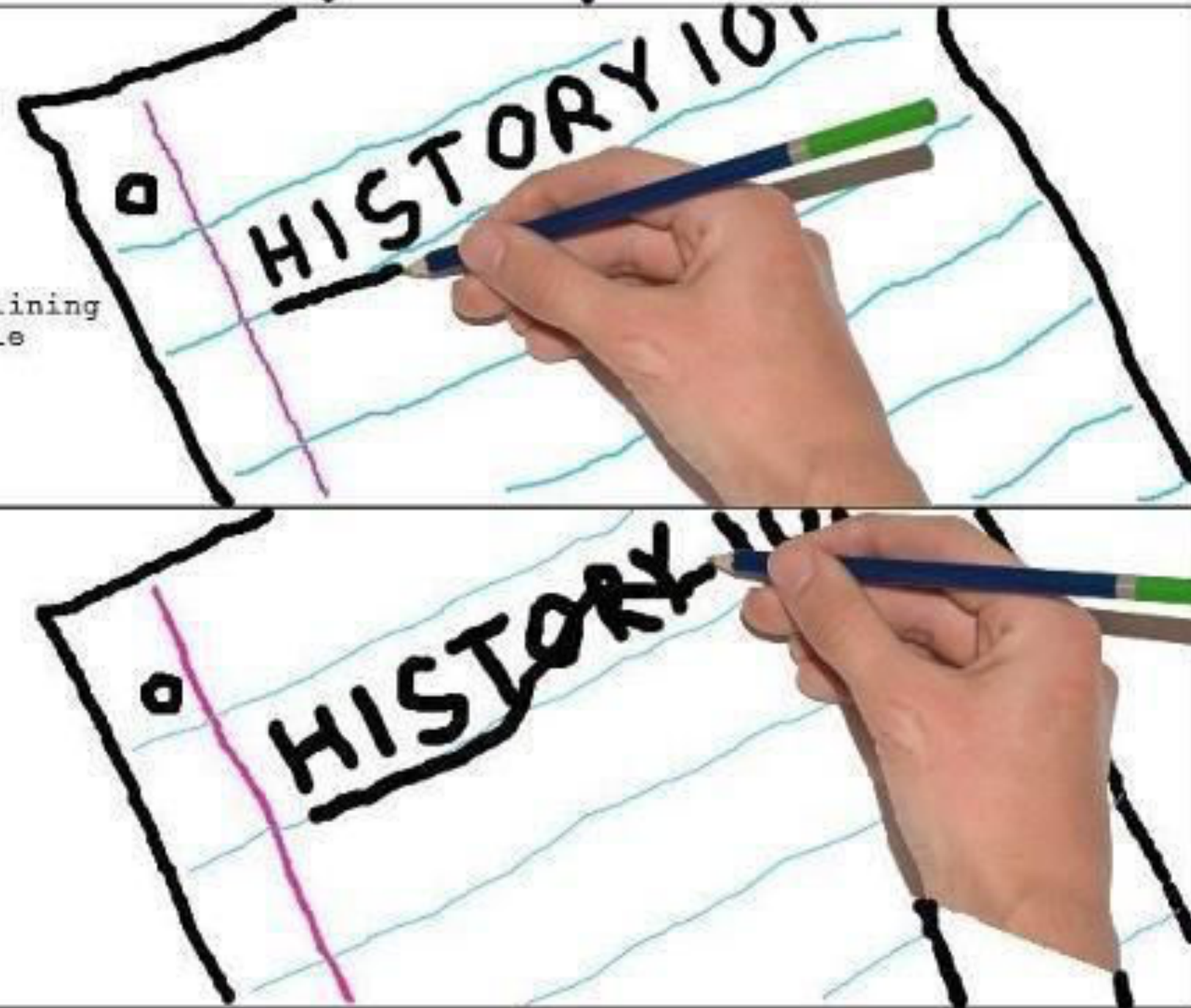
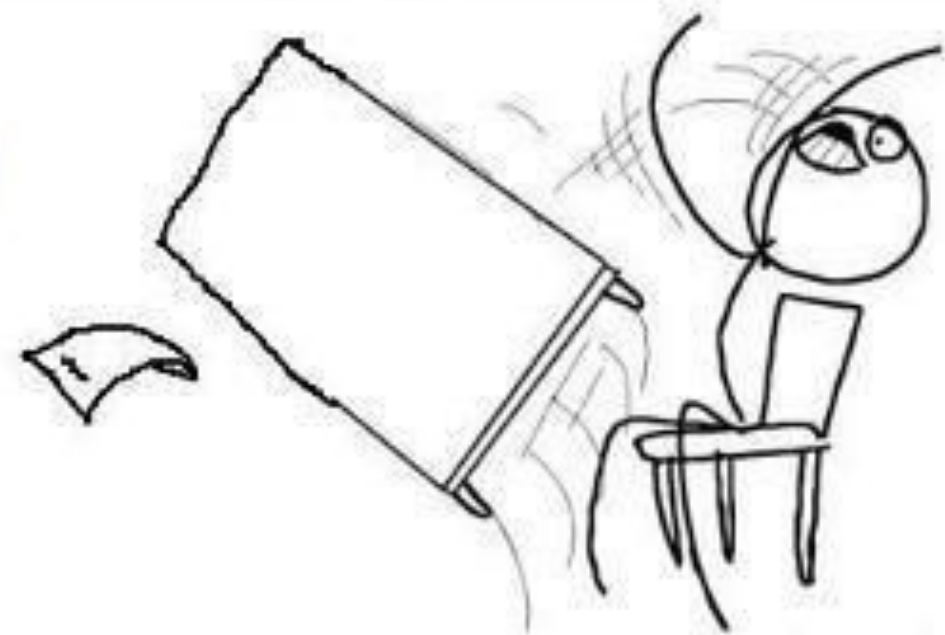

# “Era of Good Feelings”

<b>Rush-Bagot Agreement</b>	with Britain	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▶ Sets limits on number of naval ships on the Great Lakes</li><li>▶ <b>Disarmament</b> (removal of weapons) along the US and British-Canadian border</li></ul>
<b>Convention of 1818</b>	with Britain	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▶ Gives the US fishing rights off parts of Newfoundland and Labrador</li><li>▶ Sets the border of the Louisiana Territory between US and British-Canada at 49°N</li><li>▶ Agree to share the Oregon Territory for sake of fur trade</li></ul>

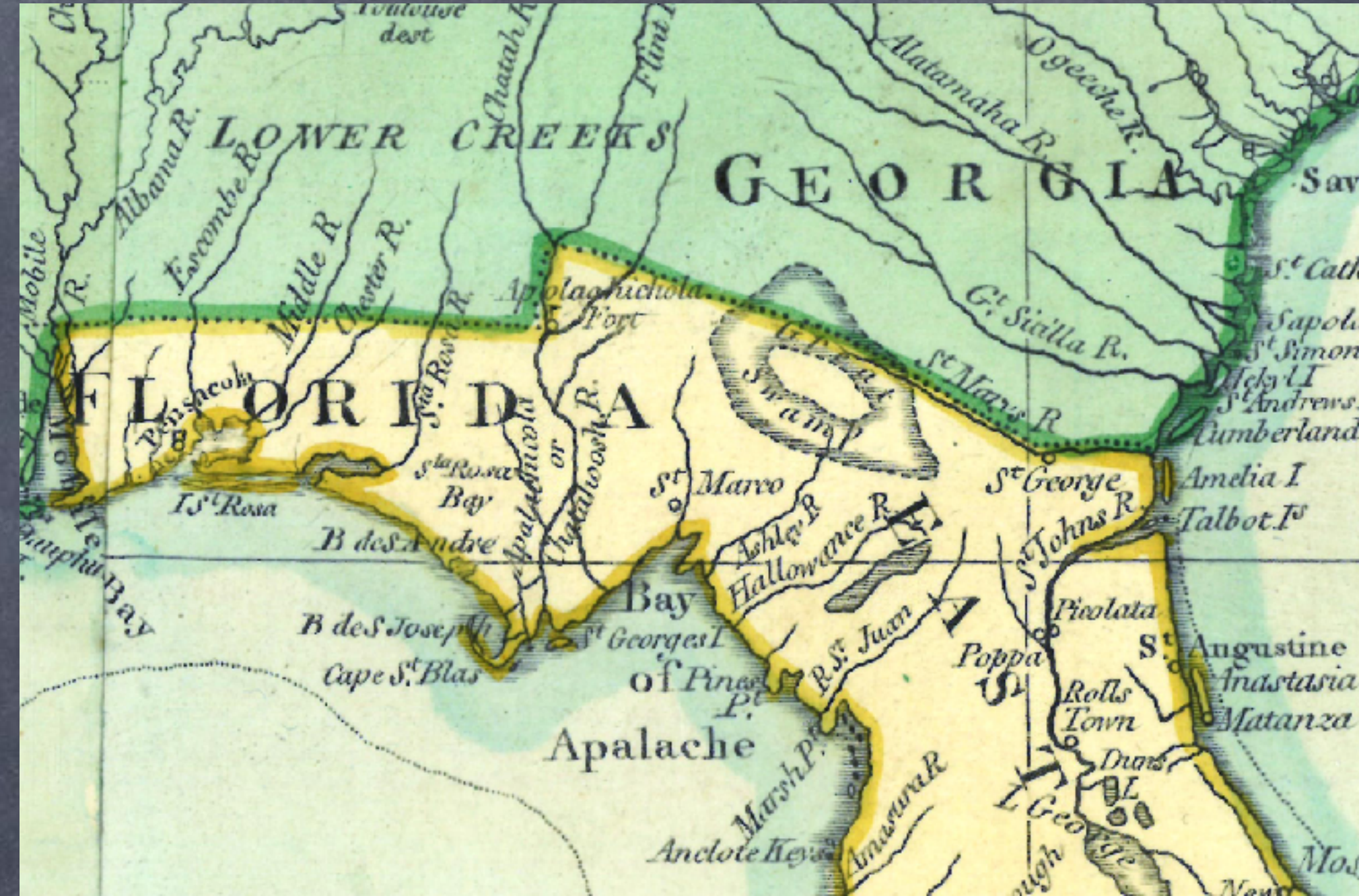

# Conflicts with the Native Americans

- ▶ Creek Indians and Seminole Indians raided the Florida-Georgia line
- ▶ Enslaved African Americans were running to Spanish Florida and finding freedom with the Seminoles.



## First Seminole War

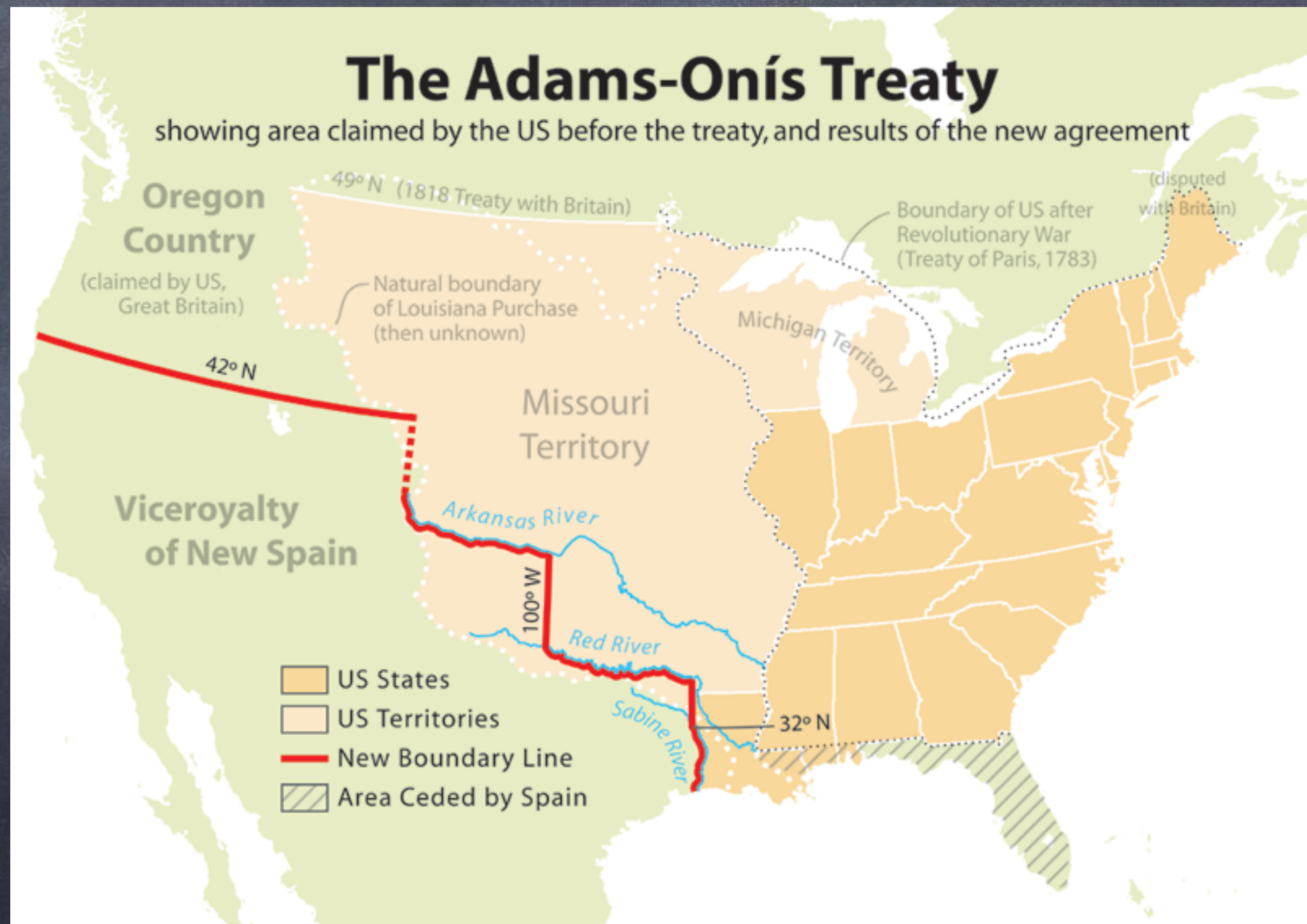
- ▶ Executed two British subjects
- ▶ Evicted the entire Spanish government from Pensacola
- ▶ Hanged two chiefs captured by deception

with Spain

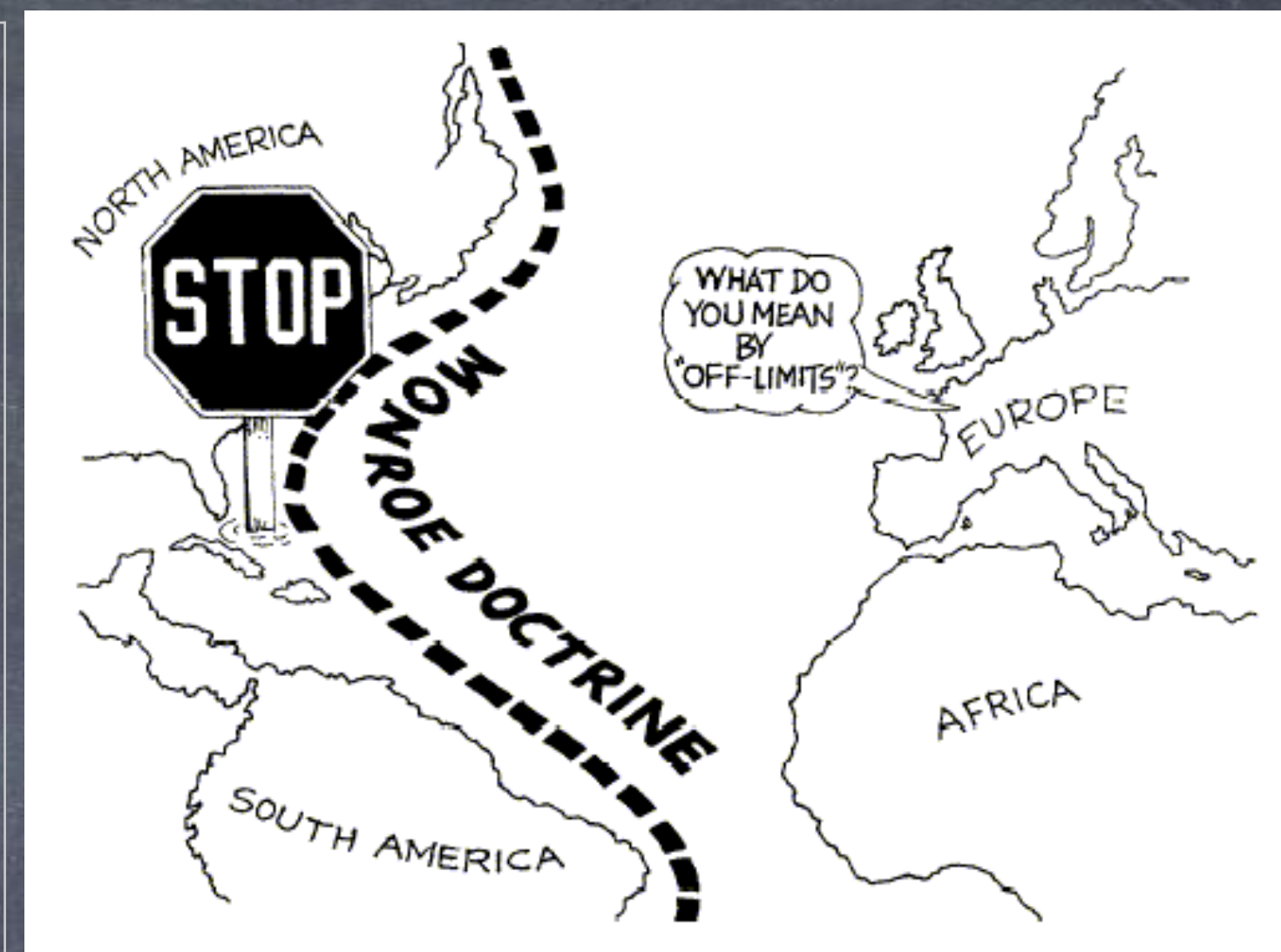
- ▶ Spain gave East Florida to the US
- ▶ US would give up claims to Texas and pay \$5 million



## Monroe Doctrine

Issued to the world

- ▶ Warns European powers to not interfere with the Americans
- ▶ The US promised to not interfere in European affairs
- ▶ The US would recognize (and not interfere with) European colonies that already existed in North and South America.
- ▶ The Western Hemisphere was off limits to further colonization
- ▶ US would consider any colonization attempts to be an act of war.



No **NEW** European colonies in the Western Hemisphere

— SUCCESS - Europeans stayed out of Latin America

— FAILURE - Newly independent Latin American countries did not like the “big brother” behavior
