NATIVE AMERICANS IN THE MEDIA



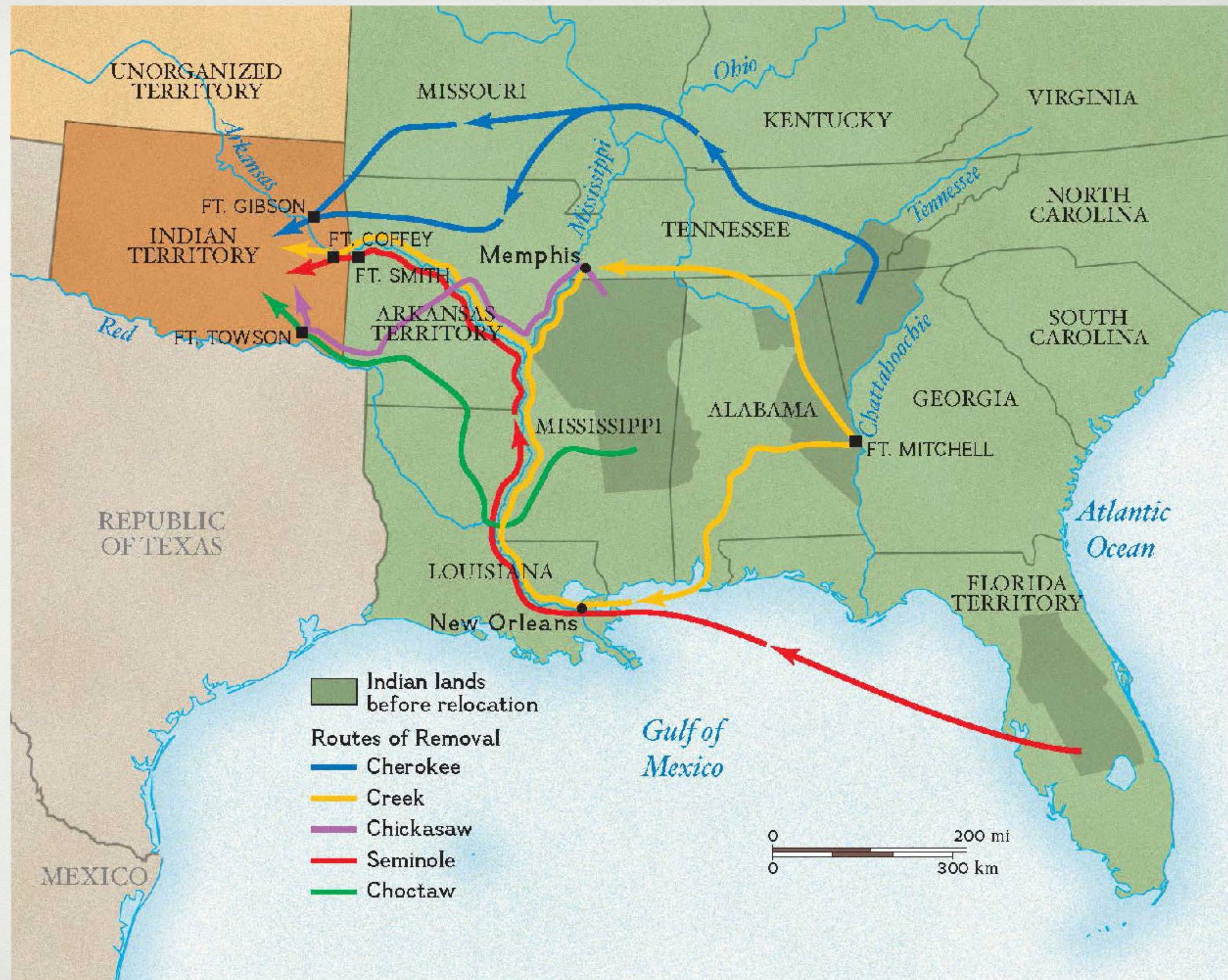

INDIAN TERRITORY = CONTROVERSY

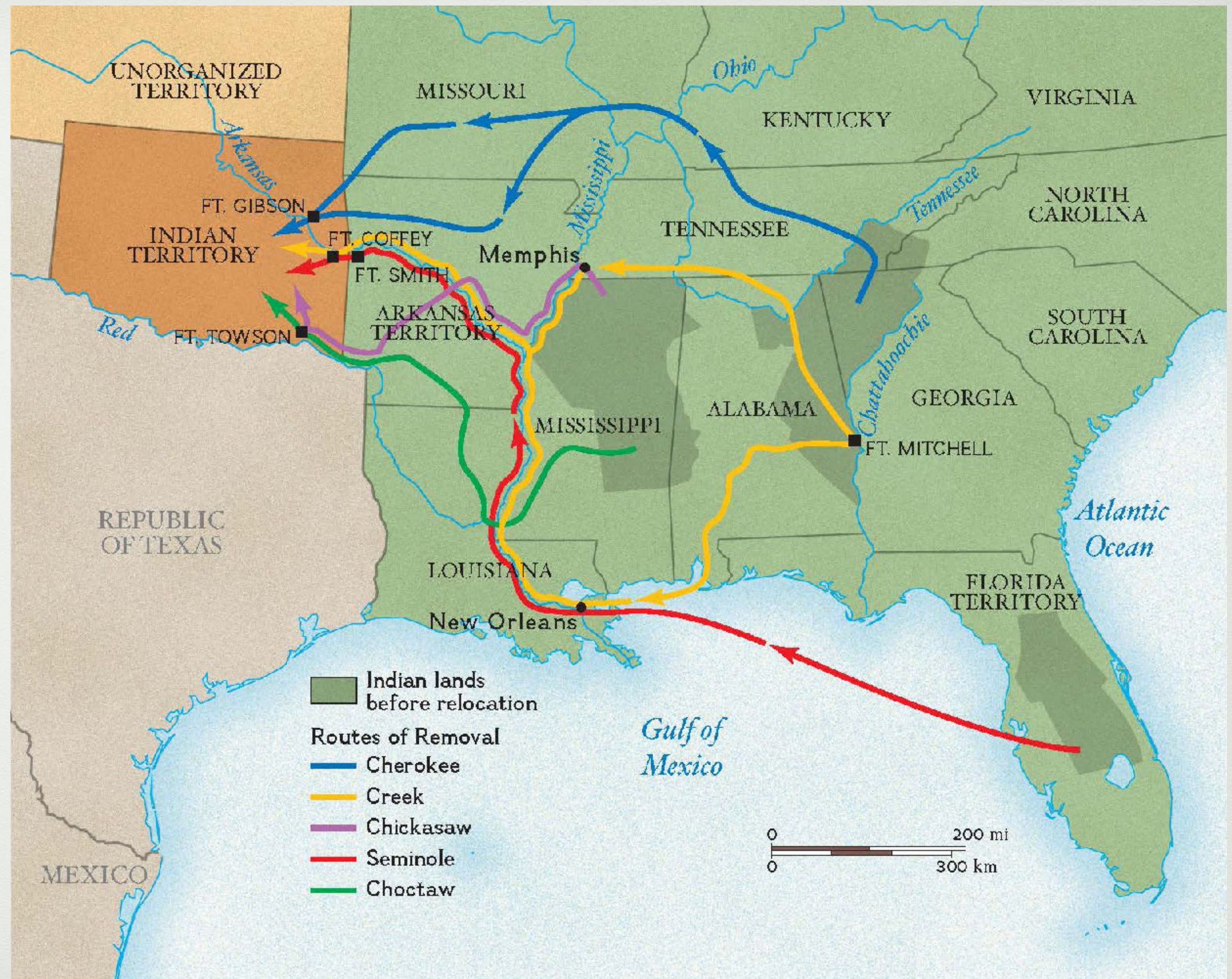
Paternalism

A practice of expanding geographically and economically, imposing their will on suppressed group and commandeering their resources
