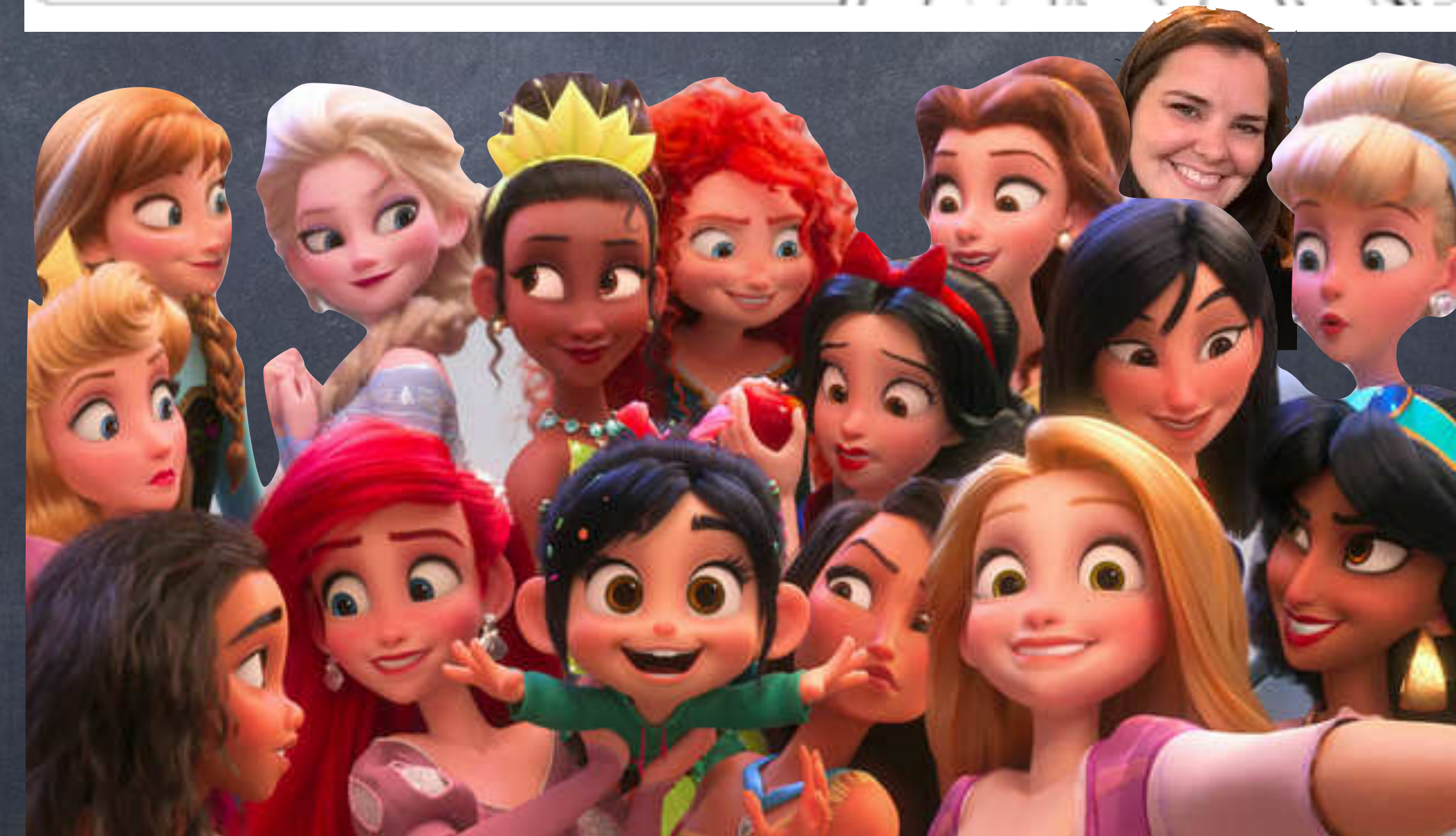

Henry Clay's American System

- ▶ **Goal: Create a unified and self-sufficient economy by...**
 - ▶ **Establishing a national bank**
 - ▶ *McCullough v. Maryland* - states have no right to interfere with federal institutions
 - ▶ **Create a single currency across all states**
 - ▶ *Gibbons v. Ogden* - gives power to the federal government to regulate commerce
 - ▶ **Pass a protective tariff**
 - ▶ benefits Northern manufacturers
 - ▶ **Improve roads and canals**
 - ▶ Cumberland Road
 - ▶ Erie Canal

sectionalism

The West

- worked on small farms
- wanted government to keep funding things like roads, canals, etc.
- keep selling cheap land



roads

The North

- worked in factories & mills
- wanted government to put taxes on foreign goods (politicians), & protect their ships and trade (merchants)



The South

- worked on farmland
- wanted government to protect & spread slavery, oppose tariffs
