<u>Impressment</u>

• British would take American sailors and force them to serve in the military

Barbary States

- Present-Day North Africa
 - Most active: **Tripoli** (present day Libya)
- Asked for tribute = continue to attack our ships
 - We blockade Tripoli
 - **USS Philadelphia** runs aground the pirates take its crew prisoner and plan to use the ship to attack American vessels
 - Stephen Decatur, an American sailor, sneaks onto the ship and lights the ship on fire so they
 can't use it
 - At the same time, the US marines launch a surprise attack on Tripoli.

Trade Limitations

- Embargo Act: bans trade with all foreign nations (imports and exports)
 - We thought it would put pressure on France and Britain = NOPE! Hurts us more!
 - Leads to an increase in smuggling
- Non-Intercourse Act: bans trade with only Britain and France
